

TALK WITH THE VICE CHANCELLOR



PROF. G. RAGHURAMA (VICE-CHANCELLOR)

1. SIR, WHAT DO YOU LIKE ABOUT THE UNIVERSITY, THE MOST?

I think a good impression works wonder. The green campus, well-maintained infrastructure, cleanliness, and lavish greenery attract everyone who comes to the university. Added to that we are in Dehradun, a city well known for its beauty.

Infrastructure is an important part of a university but that does not define the university. It's the students, faculty, and staff who make the university worth it. After interacting with a lot of DITians, I am quite impressed with their enthusiasm, confidence, and willingness to learn and achieve greater heights in life.

Before joining DIT University, I researched a bit about the management of the university, and I was happy to find out that they emphasize on quality and have a clear goal of taking the institute to a higher level. DIT began its journey in 1998 and became a university in 2013. For a young university, I am happy to note that DIT holds all the required elements in place and has a great enthusiasm to grow. DIT has committed people working for the betterment of the university and that is something I am very happy to see

2. SIR, WHAT DO YOU CONSIDER TO BE THE MAIN CHALLENGES FACED BY DIT UNIVERSITY?

Life is full of challenges, but persistence is a huge key to overcoming those challenges. DIT University needs to achieve its full potential in terms of ensuring the quality of students, teaching and research infrastructure, faculty, and overall management.

It needs to compete with the already established educational institutes. We cannot do all things in one shot. We have to prioritize and have to overcome the constraints by optimizing the limited resources we have, in terms of space, finance, and people.

3. SIR, IS THERE A VISION FOR RESEARCH THAT YOU HAVE FOR THE UNIVERSITY?

Research can find answers to things that are unknown and fill gaps in knowledge. There are universities that are mainly focused on research, and there are others whose main focus is on teaching. A university like ours may be more focused on teaching & learning, but that alone can't work without giving importance to research. To do better quality teaching, we should give sufficient importance to research at all levels.

Research is a resource-intensive field. It requires huge investment in terms of money, people, and space. DIT cannot compete with other established research universities on this count. However, we should understand that research is not about only growing the PhD numbers, but it has to percolate down to postgraduate and undergraduate (mainly final year) levels. That will enrich the curriculum. It is not our near-term goal to transform DIT into a research-focused university. We are focusing on making DIT university the best teaching institution with good quality research embedded in it. We have some research centers of excellence, and we have a goal to make them more effective. A full-fledged research program will be part of DIT's goal in the next 5 years.

4. SIR, WHAT WILL BE YOUR PRIMARY FOCUS AT THE UNIVERSITY?

Every university has to move on to the next milestone. For this, we need to understand where we want to be and how to reach there. We must understand the strength of the existing system and have a plan for the next 5 to 10 years.

Higher education system regulation in the country is passing through sudden changes. What used to be considered good is no longer enough. We must understand the changes and learn to quickly adapt. We need to have clarity and strong planning to overcome the constraints. Sometimes gradual steps are necessary while other times big steps do the work. My job is to assess and implement that change. We must take all the stakeholders- students, faculty, staff, management, and alumni together to bring in the desired changes.

It is not me alone who will make that change happen. It is our collective effort that will transform us. If we are determined, together we can make things happen. And leading that effort is my job.

5. SIR, WHAT MESSAGE WOULD YOU LIKE TO GIVE TO THE STUDENTS OF THE EDITORIAL BOARD?

Don't settle for mediocrity, don't let well enough be good enough. You should often look behind to see how far you have come. I understand that the quality of the editorial content has significantly become better over the years, yet there is always a chance for improvement.

An editor is an integral part of the Editorial Board, but he can't do anything alone. He should lead the team and allow others to challenge him. The importance of working as a team is often talked about, but not many know how to put that into practice. It's imperative for your success as it teaches you a lot, so take others' opinions as well and learn team building.

AWARENESS AND TRAINING PROGRAM ON IP





SESSION ON SPIC MACAY - 11TH MARCH



WEBINAR ON, "HYBRID QUANTUM TECHNOLOGIES"



WEBINAR ON. "ADVANCES IN HEAT ENGINEERING"



LECTURE ON, "EDUCATION, OPPORTUNITY, SUCCESS AND HAPPINESS"




