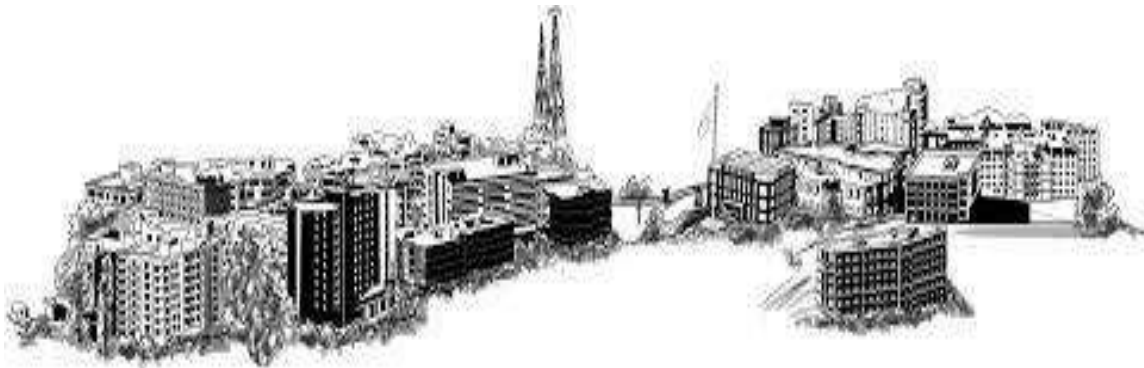

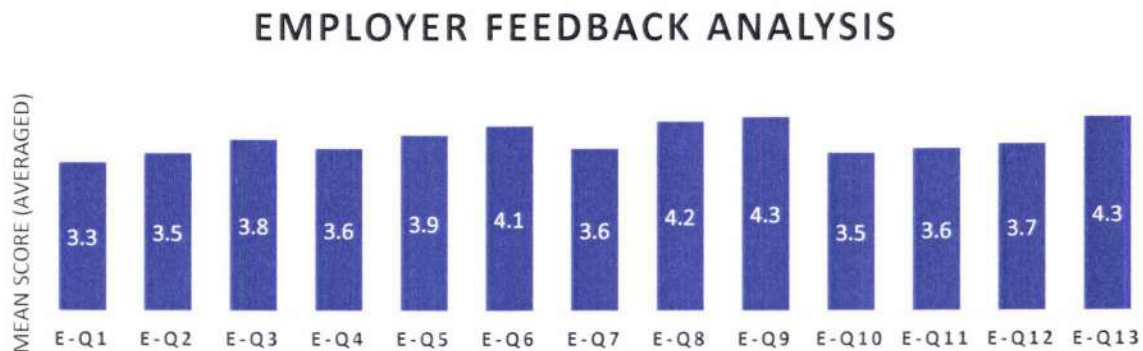


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

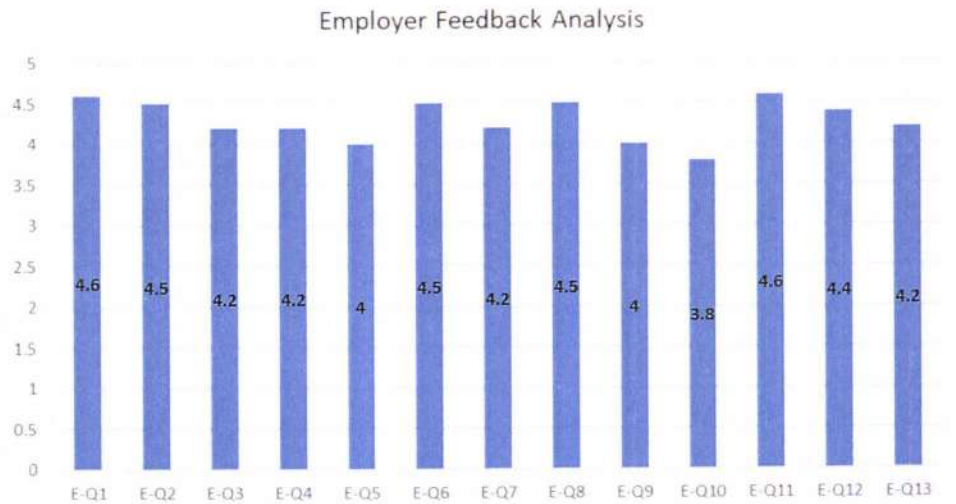


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

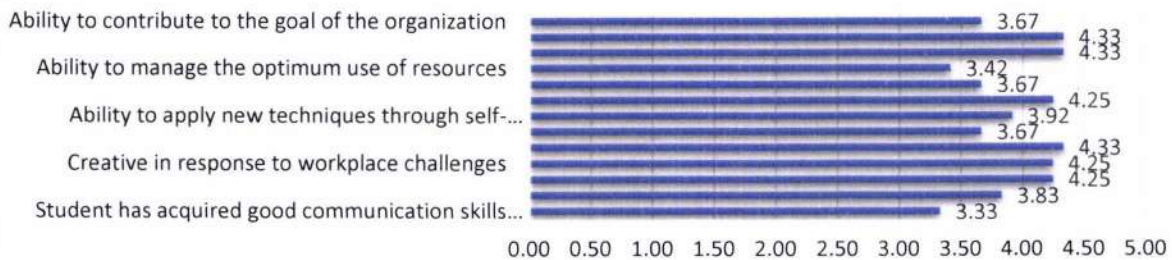
**Curriculum Feedback Analysis**

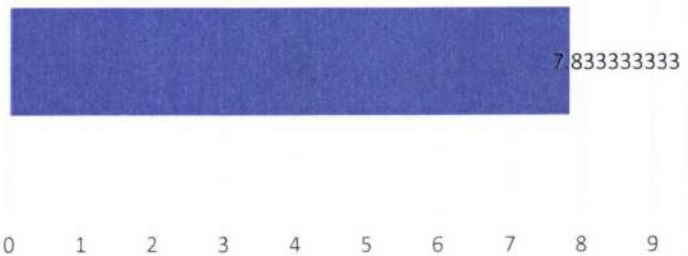

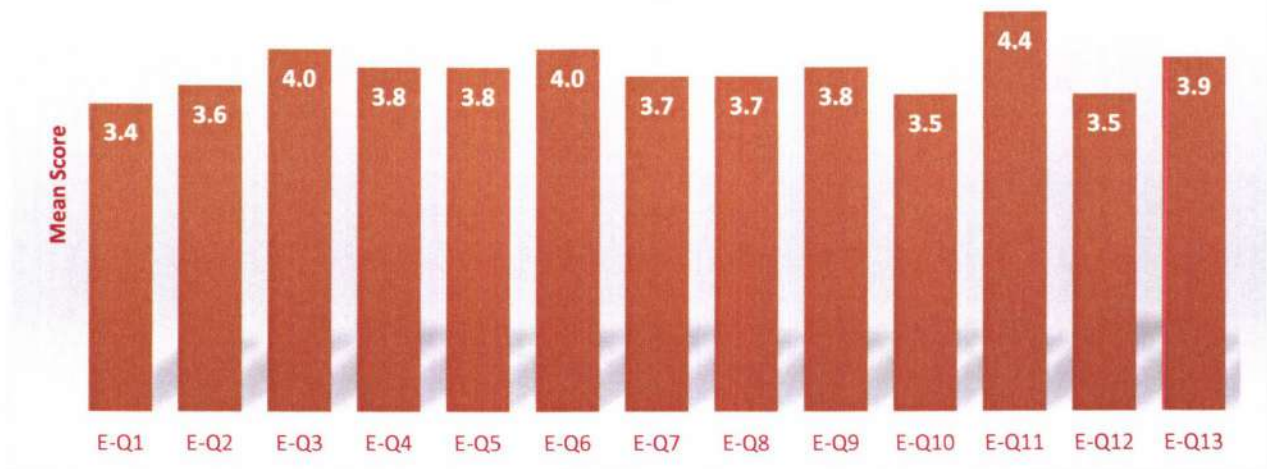

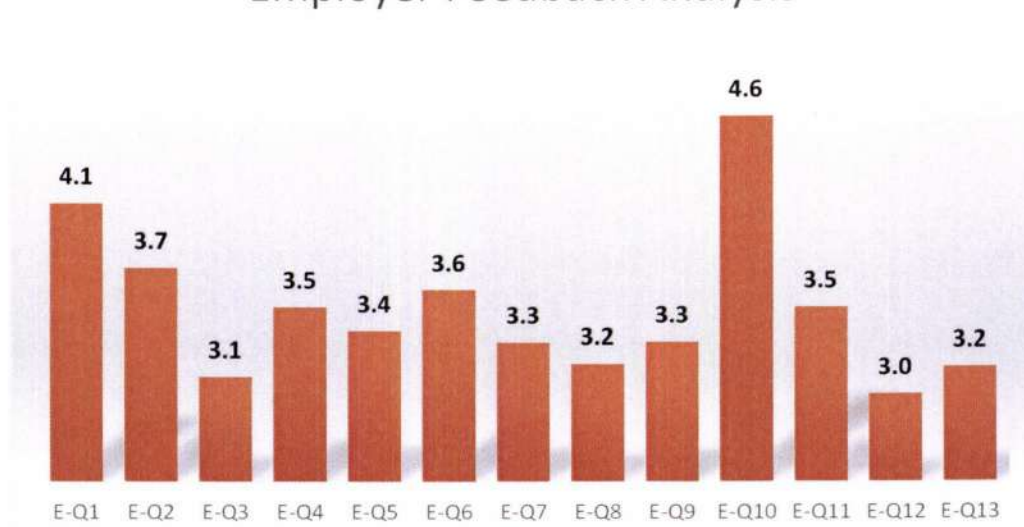


Figure 1: Employer feedback mean scores.

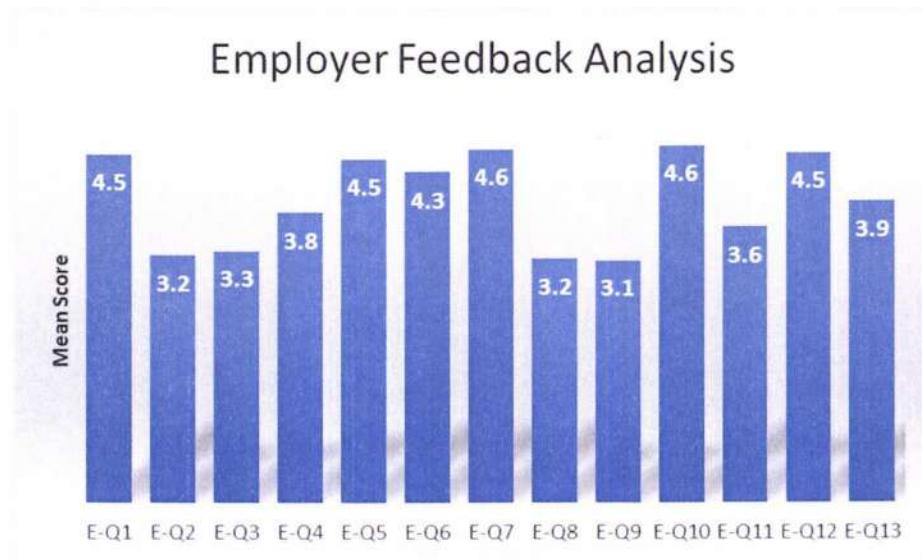



Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

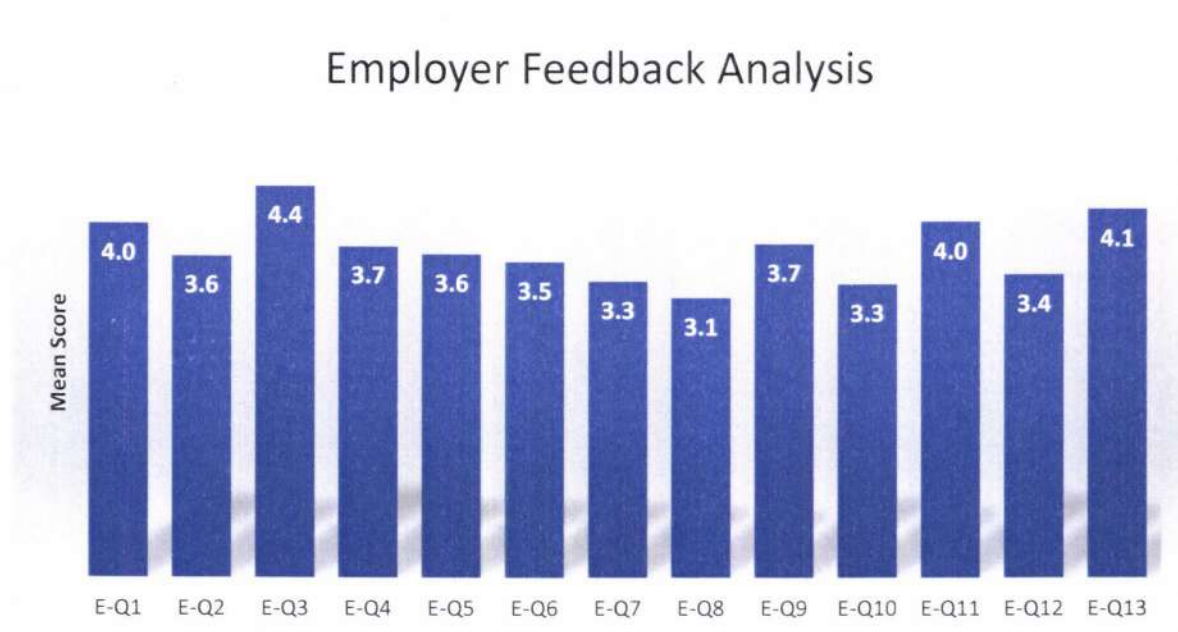


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

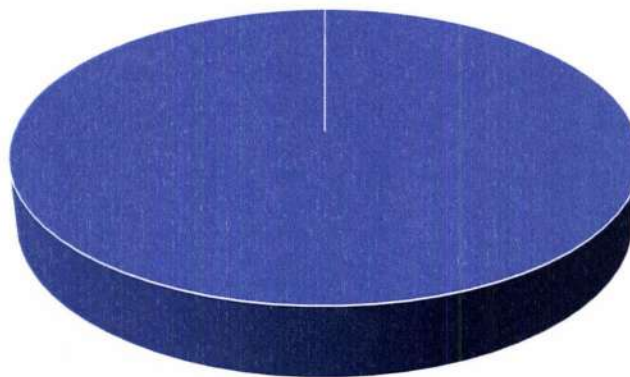

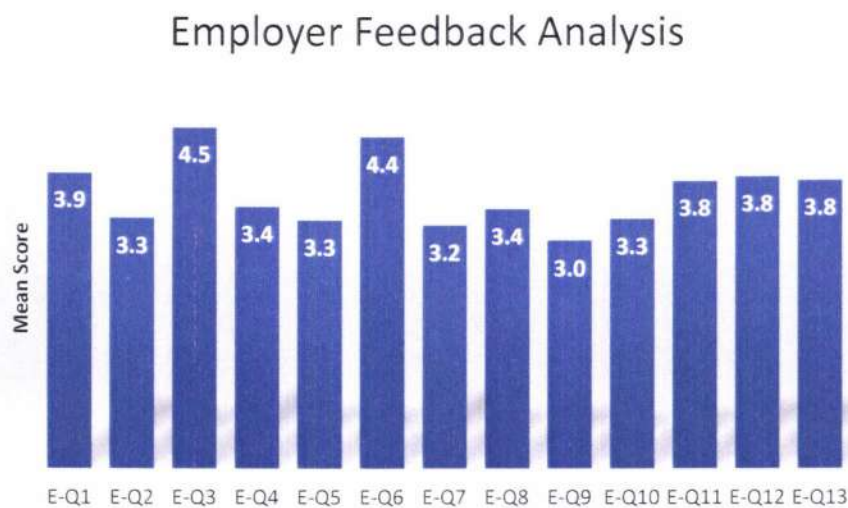


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

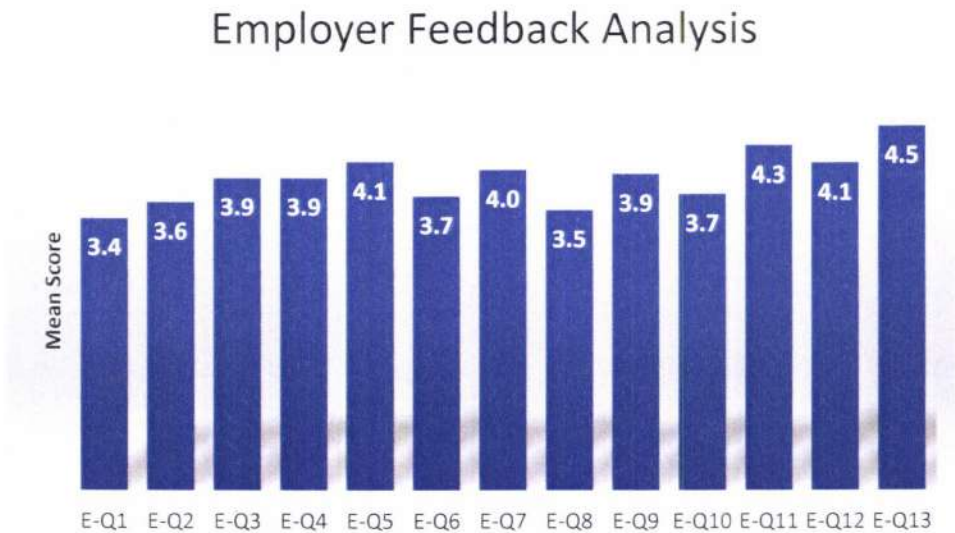


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.
