DEHRADUN: The Central Pollution Control Board conducted a workshop at DIT University taking seriously the three non-attainment cities that are not meeting the attenment parameter quality discussed about them in which a proposal on the points that came out will be discussed and its implementation will be considered. Officials from smart city project, State urban development department, forest department etc. also participated in this workshop.



The program was started by Pro Vice Chancellor DIT K K Raina and all the guests with lighting the lamp. In the workshop, Member Secretary, State Pollution Control Department, SP Subuddi ex-

pressed concern over the three main non-attenmant cities of the Uttarakhand that is, Dehradun, Rishikesh and Kashipur, saying that pollution levels in these three cities have increased a lot in the

last few years. Prof. BR Gurjar, from IIT Roorkee in the workshop, also expressed concern about the fact that the speed with which pollution is increasing in these cities is not far off when our mountains will also be untouched by it. For this, we have to find some such measures so that the economy of the state is not affected too and pollution can also be controlled. He said that we need to focus

more on petrol, diesel-free vehicles and take some concrete decisions that can control pollution. For this it was a brain storming workshop in which a proposal has been prepared which will be pre-sented to the higher authorities soon. On this occasion, the workshop was organized by Dr. Ankur Kansal in DIT University and Dr. Tarumay Ghoshal with Dr. Naveen Singhal were present.

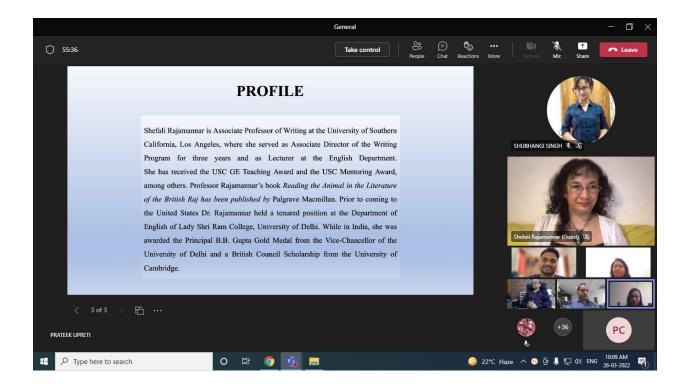




