Since it is developed on the Iberian Peninsula, Spanish is also referred to as Iberian Romance languages like Galician, Portuguese, Catalan, etc. Like many other Romantic languages such as French, Italian, Portuguese, Romanian, etc.

The Spanish language has its roots in Latin, which was brought to the Iberian Peninsula after the Roman conquest in the 3rd-2nd centuries BC. In the 13th century, King Alfonso made that dialect (Castilian) the official language of government administration.
