

LANGUAGE COURSE –SPANISH

Course Objective:

The course is designed to provide the participants with a good idea of Spanish language, include typical themes, grammar and vocabulary fields. This will be flexible rather than prescriptive, in that teachers may decide to adapt their learning plans to the specific level, aims and interests of the class.

Prerequisite:

- No previous Spanish language knowledge is required.
- The course is recommended to anyone who wants to learn Spanish language fast and easy and is designed for beginners. We start with the absolute basics.

Overview of Training:

Through the Spanish for Beginners program, you will learn to:

Understand and communicate in Spanish in everyday situations; develop basic speaking, listening, reading and writing skills; learn vocabulary and expressions to talk about everyday topics; become aware of the cultural diversity of the Spanish-speaking world; and develop your study skills to become a successful language learner.

In particular, you will learn the language necessary to: greet people, say where you live and what languages you speak; describe people and what they wear, talk about your family and home ;talk about daily life, what you do and when things happen; talk about your hobbies, likes and dislikes; make phone calls, book accommodation, shop for food or clothes, and get things done; and ask for directions, order food and drinks when you're out and about.



What am I going to get from this course?

By the end of the course, you will build and develop your practical communication skills in Spanish speaking, writing, and reading and, of course, your fluency and grammatical accuracy. Reach your Spanish language goals now and in the future, increasing your opportunities for both personal and professional success

Intended Audience:

All the students across all the program.

Learning Outcome:

The student has a good command of German. He/she learns to express him/herself clearly both in speaking and writing on a large number of topics and to understand almost all texts. For example: Art: fine arts - interviews given by artists - interpretation of art, learning German: experiences and problems in assimilating a foreign language, sports, Austrian regional studies, Austria-Germany-Switzerland comparison, use of different types of text, literature (poetry).

Course Outline:

Student as a language user will be able to understand sentences and frequently used expressions related to particular topics relevant to the student: information about themselves and their family, shopping, restaurants, professions, places.

Students will know how to communicate to perform simple and routine tasks requiring a simple and direct exchange of information. Enrolled Student is able to understand clear texts on familiar topics, both in work situations, study or leisure.
