VISIT OF REPRESENTATIVES OF TATA CONSULTANCY SERVICES AND IT EXPERTS

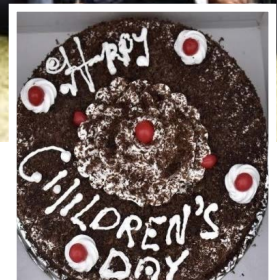

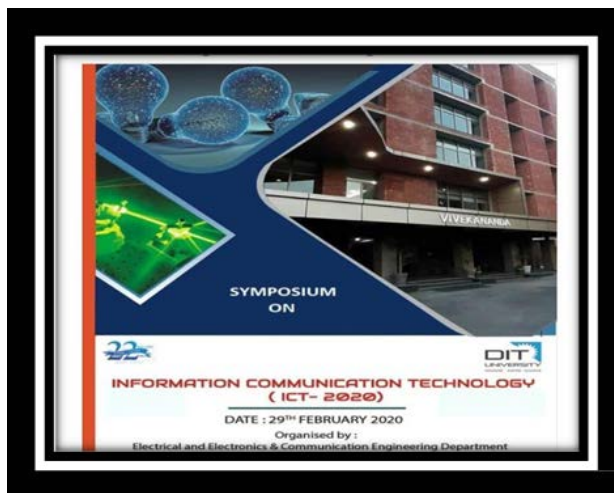

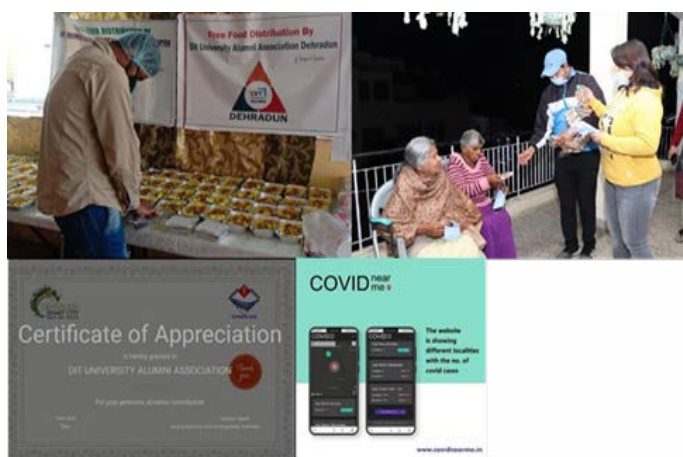

MOU WITH C-DAC, PUNE

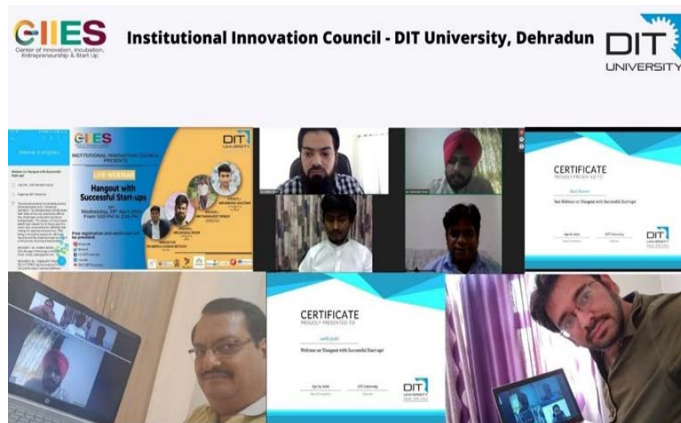

With an astounding score of 145/150, the university has successfully proved its best practices in Information-Technology. IQAC AT DIT UNIVERSITY

IQAC in DIT University has been established in December 2014 with a purpose to develop a self- driven feedback-based quality mechanism. Since then there are several initiatives that have been taken, year after year, to ensure continuous improvements in the quality in teaching-learning and assessment processes in the university. - DIT University rated “DIAMOND” in FACULTY QUALITY by QS-IQUAGE thus becoming only second university in India to achieve so.
- DIT University got AAA star rating in its academic and administrative audit during the year.
- DITU participated in NIRF 2020 and received 129th rank in Engg. Category.
- DITU adopted five villages in neighborhood as a part of our commitment to contribute in upliftment and development of the society.

CENTERS OF EXCELLENCE

The University strategically established the following five Centers of Excellence to promote the innovation by providing hands on training on cutting-edge technologies. Following Five Laboratories established as Centers of Excellence in various engineering and scientific fields.

Industrial Automation & Robotics (IAR) Laboratory

The primary objective of this IAR laboratory is to bridge the technological gap and focus on training programs to



This lab will help in catering to the growing demand from engineering and low cost automation with hydraulics and pneumatics in India as well as

worldwide. This Centre is an initiative by DIT University to prepare engineering graduates to full fill the requirements of the industry. The Centre has world class infrastructure supported by HYDAC-Germany, equipment's, training kits, hardware, software and teaching aids with trained faculty. The center has six laboratories on Hydraulics, Pneumatics, Sensorics, PLCs, Measurement technology and 6 axis industrial robots. The center aims to provide hands on training to engineering students as well as industry professionals. These trainings will enhance the understanding of the students for better employability.

Nano Technology & Photonics

• Advanced Functional Smart Materials Laboratory

The primary goal of this laboratory is to provide state-of-the-art facilities to in-campus and outside users from various universities, academia, industries and society. Our team is currently engaged in the cutting-edge research of soft materials and nano colloids, green technologies and energy harvesting, purification and dye degradation, functional and high K dielectric materials, photocatalytic smart surfaces, sensors, energy storage devices,

carbon nanomaterials and graphene for water purification and mesoscopic transport etc. In this laboratory, we have synthesis facilities such as spin coating unit, ultrasonic bath, hot air oven, centrifugal Unit, hydrothermal reactor, photocatalytic reactors, a complete facility for nanoparticles and nanocomposites/ nano colloids synthesis. Apart from this, the available characterization facilities are UV-Visible spectrophotometer, Polarizing Optical Microscope, conductivity measurement, optical transmittance measurement, electro-optical and polarization measurements etc.

Centre of excellence in Land, Air and Water (CoE-LAW)

DIT University is proud to establish center of excellence(COE) in Land, Air, Water (LAW). The sole objective of this COE is to enhance research and knowledge sharing in the various dimensions of environment. For this very purpose, DIT university is working with Uttarakhand Pollution Control board (UKPCB) for air quality monitoring and has received two air samplers from the UKPCB. DIT university is also in the process of discussions with various private companies and NGOs to have joint initiatives in this COE. The center has started growing

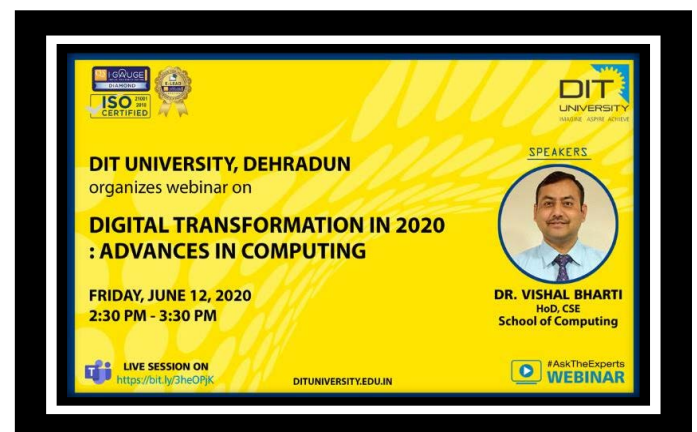
WEBINAR ON 'PROFESSIONAL EDUCATION SCENARIO POST COVID – 19'

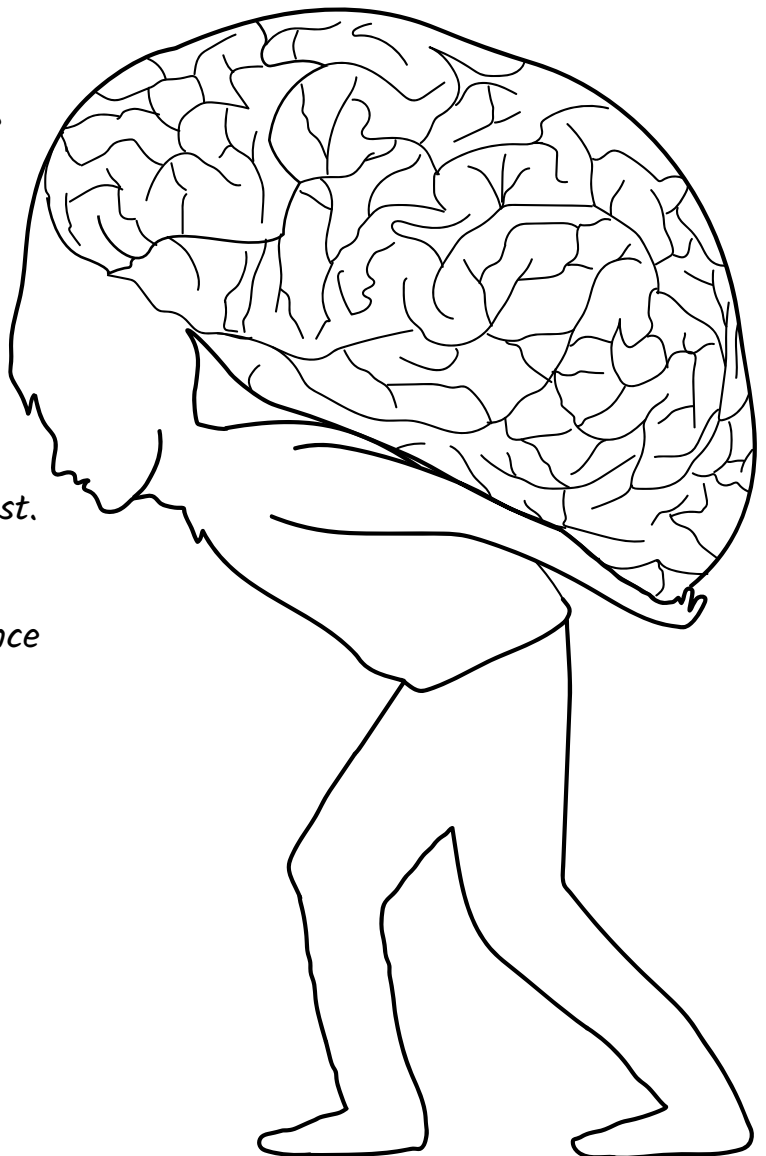
On a very serious note-
