ARDUINO WORKSHOP

The IETE Student Forum under the guidance of the EECE Department organised the Arduino Workshop on 17th October 2018. Arduino is a pen-source electronic prototyping

platform enabling users to create interactive electronic objects. 24 students from B. Tech 2nd year participated in it. These students were introduced to the basics of creating Arduino: ultrasonic sensors - a type of acoustic sensor, 7 segment display - a form of electronic display device for displaying decimal numerals which is an alternative to the more complex dot matrix displays and RGB LED. They also created a few prototypes and implemented a few circuits using Proteus - a proprietary

software tool suite used primarily for electronic design automation.

The workshop not only made the students familiar with several software tools, but also deepened their primary knowledge in automation and its basics. They also learnt how to create schematics and electronic prints for manufacturing printed circuit boards and several different models using the software.
