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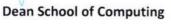

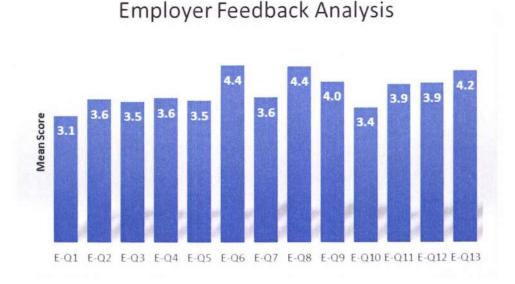


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

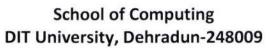

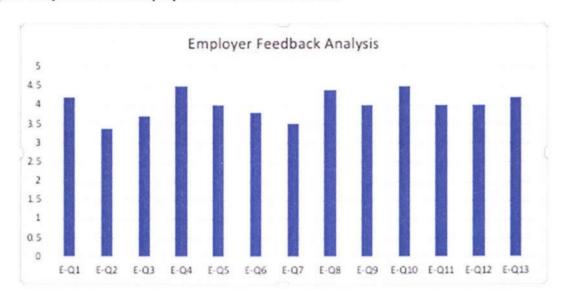


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

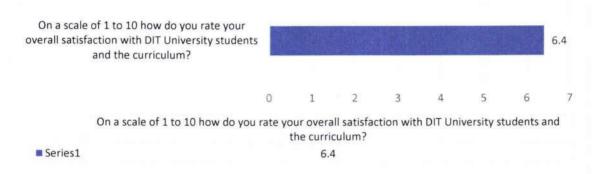

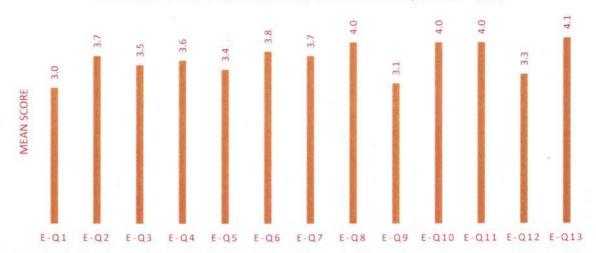

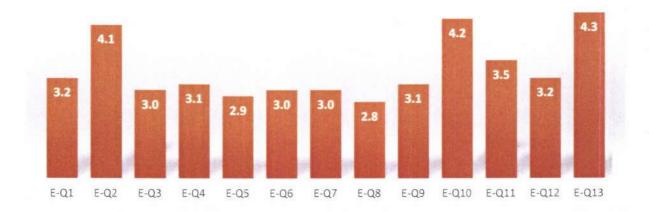


Figure: Employer feedback mean scores.

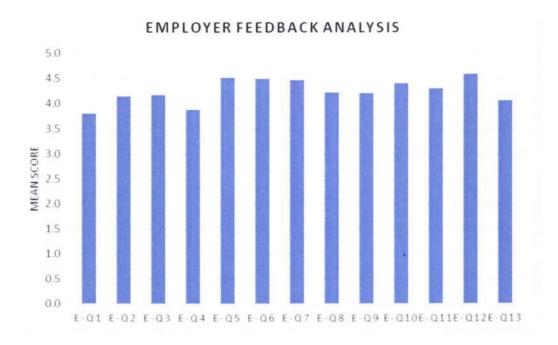


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

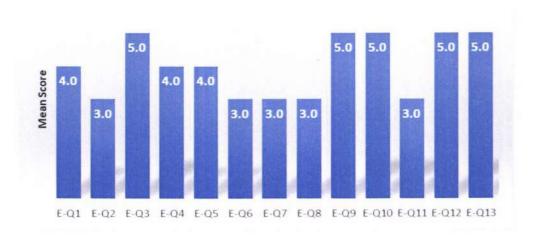


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

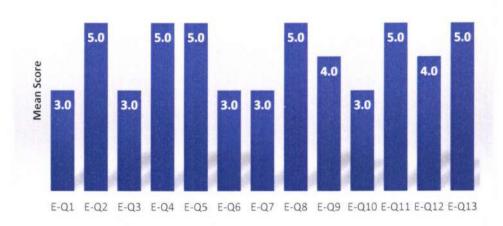


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

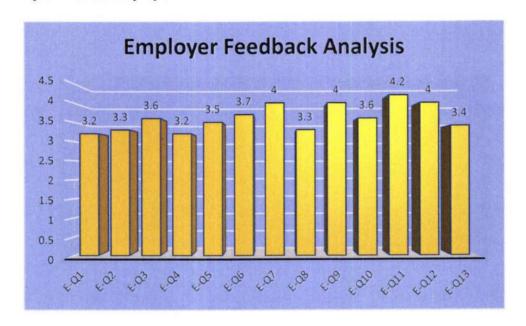


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

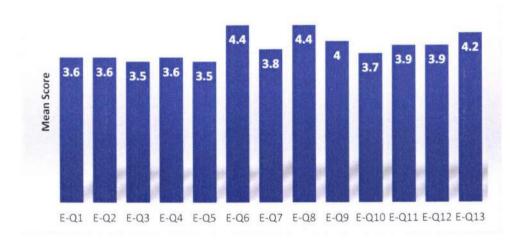


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

The first statement "I am satisfied with the program that my ward undergoing in terms of load of the courses in the trimesters" has attained mean score 4 which shows somewhere parents have agreed on this statement. The second statement "The text and reference books related to courses are available in the market" has attained mean score 4.08. It shows parents have also agreed on the availability of text and reference books in the market. 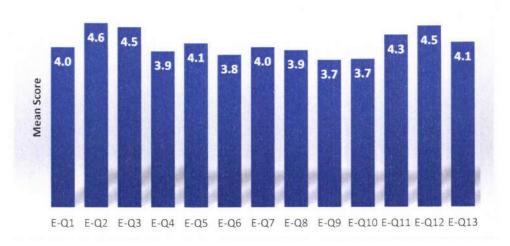


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

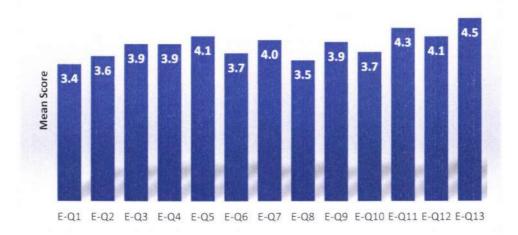


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.

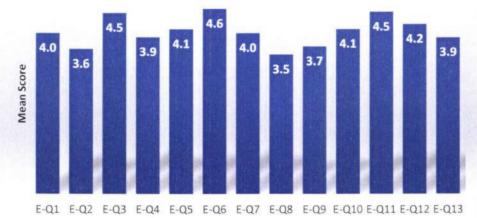


Figure 4: Employer feedback mean scores.
