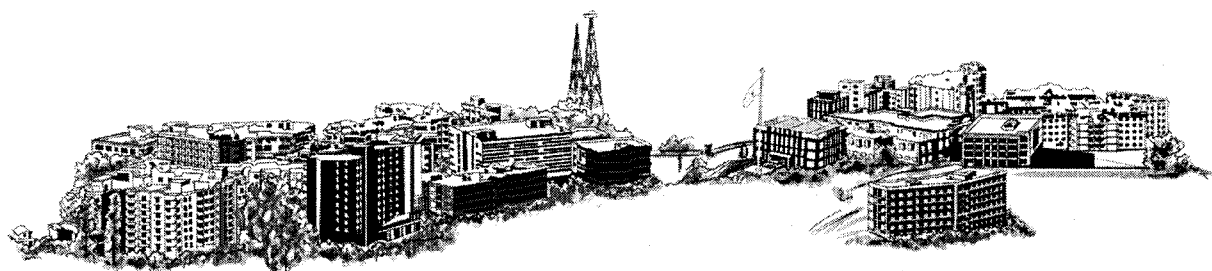




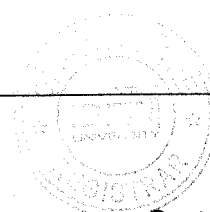

Economics</p> <ol style="list-style-type: none">1. In the 8th BOS, the department present the course structure and syllabus for B.A. (Honours) Economics for 1st, 2nd and 3rd (2022 – 2025) batch.2. The expert is also recommended to change the name of Entrepreneurship and Multinational Enterprises as Entrepreneurship Development. Accordingly, all contents of this subject were revised.3. The name of Application of Statistical Software in Economic Analysis was also changed as Application of Statistical Tool for Economic Analysis.4. The name of Econometrics is also suggested to renamed as Basic Econometrics.5. Economics Programme.7. The department also present the syllabus for course work of PhD Economics for session 2022 onwards.8. The syllabus for course work for PhD Economics for session 2022 onwards was discussed and approved.


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B.A. (Hons.) English
