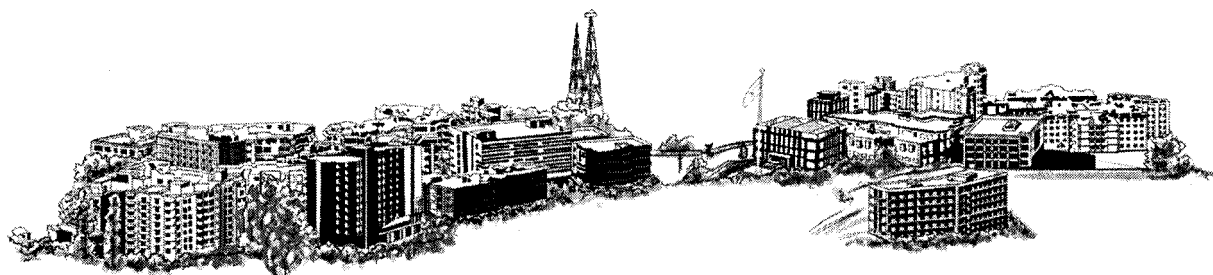

1	Item No. 11.4: To deliberate on the proposed course structure and first-year syllabus of the B.Sc / B.Sc (Hons.)/B.Sc (Hons. with Research) Chemistry 4-year program as per NEP.	After due deliberations and discussions board approved the proposed overall course structure and syllabus of the B.Sc / B.Sc (Hons.)/B.Sc (Hons. with Research) Chemistry 4-year program as per NEP with and without a minor. As per the suggestions of the board members, tutorials were removed from a few courses to reduce the number of credits required for the B.Sc. (H) Chemistry degree (4-year program).
